



## 1847 WINERY 170TH ANNIVERSARY BAROSSA VALLEY SHIRAZ CABERNET 2020

### BACKGROUND

“170” is a limited-edition wine specially crafted by 1847 Winery to commemorate its 170th anniversary. More than just a bottle of wine, it is a tribute that transcends time. Since 1847, we have remained rooted in the Barossa Valley, passing down the art of winemaking from generation to generation, staying true to our passion through every challenge. “170” embodies the dedication and pride of our winemakers — a symbol of legacy, resilience, and hope for the future. The vineyards are situated at elevations between 200 and 300 meters, with abundant sunlight and significant diurnal temperature variation, which helps the grapes achieve an excellent balance between sugar and acidity. The vines average over 35 years of age, producing low yields of exceptional quality that perfectly showcase the unique terroir of the Barossa Valley.

### VINTAGE REPORT

The 2020 vintage posed significant challenges for the Barossa wine industry, as yields were at least 50% below the 10 - year average due to a combination of below-average rainfall in winter and spring, unpredictable spring weather, and a hot, dry period in December and early January. Despite the limited crop, the quality of the resulting wines was exceptionally high, with producers noting deep colour, intense flavour concentration, and strong aromatic profiles especially in red varieties. This combination of high quality and reduced supply means that wines from this vintage are expected to remain in strong demand both domestically and internationally.

### WINEMAKING

This Barossa Valley blend of 80% Shiraz and 20% Cabernet Sauvignon was crafted to showcase the complementary strengths of these two classic varieties. The grapes are handpicked and carefully selected, then fermented at low temperatures in open fermenters to preserve their vibrant fruit flavors. The wine is subsequently matured for 22 months in new French oak barrels (70%) and new American oak barrels (30%) to enhance complexity and structure.

### TASTING NOTE

Rich deep purple to black in colour with bright scarlet red edges. The nose displays an abundance of ripe cherry but subtle oak intergaration. The palate is sensual, rich, sweet and balanced with soft layered fruit flavours melding with the savoury notes and balanced acid, all underpinned by a seamless hint of supporting oak.
